



Houndwood, Street
Wildlife Garden Maintenance Regime

Area	Maintenance Notes
Ornamental Planting	Fortnightly weeding April – October. Keep planting back from path
Clover Lawn	Cut 10 times during season, there'll be a weed element with the lawn
Ornamental Lawn	Cut grass fortnightly April – October. Selective weed killer once in Spring
Willow Copse and Willow Shrub Mix	Keep perimeter free of weeds. Coppice Willow once every 3 – 5 years
Reed Beds with Living Willow Hurdle	Willow to be kept off path as required. Willow to be pollarded or coppiced once every 3 – 4 years as required. Reeds to be thinned out every 3 years
Grass banks with wildflowers	Wildflowers must be left to grow April – October. Strim down and rake off arisings when flowering finished. Weeds will be present but large ones can be removed by hand for aesthetic purposes
Pond areas	Remove excess Algae by hand. Thin out aquatic plants as needed to ensure no more than 60% of surface is covered with plants

Residents should note that as a wildlife garden the area is not intended to look like a manicured garden at all times of the year.
